



Abstract Formatting Guidelines

1 participant - 1 abstract

- 1. The volume of abstracts** (together with the list of references, figures, and tables) should be at most three pages. The page format is A5.
- 2. Abstract title:** font Georgia, bold, size 11, center alignment, use the style "title_CLAYS"
- 3. Authors:** Georgia font, bold, size 11, center alignment. Authors are written in the form of first name and last name. Use the style "Authors_CLAYS."
- 4. Affiliations** are indicated by a footnote¹. For example: I.I. Ivanov¹, V.V. Sidorov²
- 5. Organization** (place of work or study) is executed in the format: Abbreviated name, city, e-mail and is indicated in the footnote at the bottom of the first page of the abstracts
- 6. Formatting the text of abstracts:**
 - Font - Book Antiqua, 10
 - Interval - single
 - Alignment - width
 - Use the style "Main_text_CLAYS"
- 7. File saving.** The file should be saved in .doc format; in the title, indicate the Surname, section code (C1, C2, etc.), and planned type of presentation (oral, poster). Use underscore or hyphen for separation. For example, IvanovII_C1_U.doc.
- 8. Use of Figures and Tables:** color and b/w figures of high quality are allowed. Figures should be inserted into the text in the "Special Insert" mode or through the figure insertion. Figures and tables should be inserted after they are mentioned in the text. Reference to the figure is given in parentheses - (Fig. 1), reference to the table - (Table 1).
- 9. Figure captions should be inserted after the figure.** Caption text is Cambria, italicized, 10, center alignment. Use the "Figures_CLAYS" style
- 10. Table Formatting:**
 - The width of the table should not exceed the width of the page.
 - Table Text - Cambria, 9. Use the "Table_Text_CLAYS" style.
 - Table names are given before the table. The text of the table name is in Cambria font, italic, 9, width alignment. Use the style "Table_Title_CLAYS."
- 11. Formulas:** Formulas are inserted in MS Word mode; numbering is given in parentheses - (1).
- 12. Formalization of funding and acknowledgments:** references to the grant and financial support are indicated at the end of the text. The text of references to grant and financial support - Book Antiqua font, italic, 9, width alignment. Use the "Grant_CLAYS" style
- 13. Literature formatting:** references to literature are inserted in the text in parentheses with the surname and year of publication (Ivanov et al., 2013; Ivanov and Sidorov, 2015). The list of references is given after the text without abbreviating the names of publications and journals; numbering is not required. The list of references is Cambria font, 8, and width alignment. Use the style "Literature_CLAYS."

References to publications are cited according to the requirements of the MAIC journals
